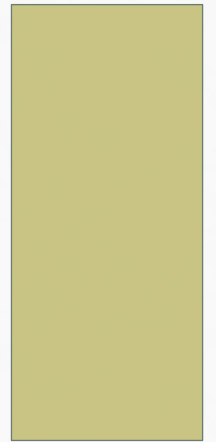

WAQFE JADID

- Waqf-e-Jadid is a blessed scheme which funds Jamaat's Tabligh activities in rural areas of Pakistan and India. It is our duty to make Ansar brothers aware of the importance of this scheme. Hadhrat Ameer ul Momineen **العزیز بنصرہ تعالیٰ ال ایده** has urged Ansar to make ensure that 100% of them take part in this blessed sceme.
- Special focus is given to building of mosques and mission houses with Waqf-e-Jadid contributions. Expenses of mu'alims (religious teachers) are also met by this scheme. For example there are over one thousand mu'alims in India and in 26 African countries as well the number of mu'alims is over one thousand. 130 new mosques and 82 mission houses were built in the last year in African countries.

HAZOOR'S MESSAGE

- Waqf-e-Jadid has expanded greatly and shows some amazing examples of financial giving. This scheme was initiated to support tarbiyyat and tabligh efforts in rural and far-off areas of Pakistan but was later extended to the rest of the world.
- It still has specific objectives and certain areas/regions are designated to benefit from it. As such only specific countries and regions are funded by contributions raised by Waqf-e-Jadid.
- Generally it is African countries and rural areas in India where Waqf-e-Jadid is funding many projects.

LAST YEAR'S COLLECTION

- With the grace of Allah the 58th year of Waqf-e-Jadid concluded on 31st December 2015 and the contributions made during the year stand at £6,891,155 which is an increase of £682,000 from last year.
- Pakistan tops the list of contributing countries.
- In 2015, in terms of contributions, after Pakistan, the first ten countries were as follows: UK, USA, Germany, Canada, India, Australia, Indonesia, a Middle Eastern country, Belgium and Ghana.

HOW THE COLLECTION ARE SPENT

- A third of the contributions received by Waqf-e-Jadid is spent in the countries where it is collected.
- One portion of the remaining two is spent in Qadian and the rest of India.
- The remainder in African and some other countries.
- In the last year 19 mosques were built in India funded by Waqf-e-Jadid as well as 23 mission houses. Expenses of Jalsa Gah in Qadian and other projects were also met.
- Two mosques and two temporary sheds were built in Nepal which is administered by Indian Jama'at.

TARGETS

- By the Grace of Allah, for the second year running UK Jamaat has finished as the best contributor to this blessed scheme outside Pakistan.
- In Order to maintain this achievement we need to Make quarterly targets to ensure collection exceeds the collection of 2015.
- 1- Zoama should obtain lists of non participant Ansar in 2015 from their local Presidents and request those Ansar to take part this year. A report on how many non-participant have contributed should be given every quarter. As we require 100% participation this target should be of utmost priority.

TARGETS

- 2- Zaoma should urge Ansar to make sure that their dependents are included in this scheme. Obtain promises of all members at latest by 31st March 2016.

TARGETS

- 3- Zoama should get the lists of new Ansar coming from Khuddam ul Ahmadiyya and ensure that they take part. If Zoama face any difficulty, they should contact markaz immediately and we will try to help them
- From september onwards Muntazim should help local Jamaats and try their best that all Ansar/dependant have paid their chanda waqfe Jadid
