## GOLDEN WORDS

**World Head of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, the Fifth Khalifa, his Holiness, Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (aba) said on National Ijtema Majlis Ansārullah UK**

“On one occasion the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) said that when the prophets (peace be upon them) asked ‘Who is it that will help me in taking people towards Allah the Almighty?’ it was because it is the law of nature that to complete grand and important tasks there is the need of helpers. Such great tasks cannot be completed by just one person. Moreover, even though the Prophets manifested the highest standards of reliance and trust upon God, according to this law of nature they still also called upon helpers.”

“In order to fulfil our pledges of being Ansarullah, and to be the true helpers of the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him), in the completion of this great and far-reaching work, we must enter the field with purpose and endeavour. Only then can we be true Ansarullah. Mere verbal claims of being so are hollow and meaningless. Rather, we must reflect upon our actual state.”

“The task of propagating the message of Islam to the corners of the Earth is no easy feat. For this we must deepen our relationship with God, increase the standards of our righteousness, strive to increase our knowledge and endeavour to live our lives in accordance with the commandments of Allah the Almighty.”

“On one occasion the Promised Messiah (peace be upon him) stated that people have now ventured far from the truth of Islam and that they have no idea what the truth of Islam is. True life in Islam requires a sort of death, in the form of hardship. But in the end, only he who attains this is truly alive. It is said in the sayings of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) that man considers the desires and luxuries of this world as heaven even though they are, in reality, hell, whilst the righteous person endures difficulties in the path of God, and this is heaven.”

“A person having stayed in the company of a Maulvi (religious cleric) and hearing his exhortations of piety and spirituality had become convinced to convert to Islam. One day the person who was due to convert came across that same cleric drinking alcohol and his heart became hardened, and he stopped. He said that this cleric tells me good and pious things and tells me about the detriment of alcohol yet he himself is sitting here drinking alcohol and so he thought to himself one should stay away from such a religion.”

“One should not just convey the message of Islam with their words, rather they should do so with their actions. They should convince others with their personal examples, by remaining steadfast and guiding others with patience. One should not become frustrated in the face of opposition. So, these two principles must always be kept in mind when conveying Islam’s teachings: to create unity in one’s actions and teachings, and secondly to act with patience, consistency and self-control.”

“Here, there are many opportunities to convey the message of Islam freely. If, in some other countries, there are obstacles in our way and the law and governments hinder us, then why should we not take advantage in those nations where we are free to do so?”

“Thus, those people who are living freely in these countries who have the opportunity to peacefully spread Islam should strive to do so to an even greater extent than before and prove by their own actions that Islam is that true religion that can bring the world to the right path and that can deliver it to salvation.”



# NATIONAL TABLIGH DAY

Qiādat Tabligh, Majlis Ansārullah UK organized National Tabligh Day on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2021 as 11:00 pm, Ansār from all regions participated in “Messiah Has Come Campaign”.



On September 5, 2021, Tabligh Day was celebrated at the central level with the permission of Majlis Ansārullah UK. This was the first outdoor activity of the Majlis Ansārullah Qaidat Tabligh, for which it was widely publicized among the Ansār brothers. The following preaching efforts were made.

On this day of preaching, Ansār participated in the campaign of "The Messiah Has Come" in different parts of the country and set up preaching stalls and distributed copies of the leaflets of "The Messiah Has Come". Each region designated one or more specific locations where Ansār from all the Majalis of the region gathered and then spread in groups for leafleting. The preaching campaign began with a silent prayer. In addition,

Tabligh stalls were set up at the popular places where Jamaat's literature and books were distributed. The program began at 11:00am in each region and lasted for at least three hours. The details of this Tabligh Day are as follows.

## PARTICIPATION OF THE REGION:

This program was celebrated at regional level across the country in which all the regions participated. 533 Ansār from 115 Majalis participated in it.

## "THE MESSIAH HAS COME" CAMPAIGN:

More than 7,000 Leaflets of "The Messiah Has Come" were distributed on the Tabligh Day. On this occasion, it was arranged that where the leaflets would be distributed, the poster of "The Messiah Has Come" would also be arranged.

## TABLIGHI STALLS:

All the regions except one have set up one or more Tablighi stalls at the designated places. More than 477 books and Jamaat's literature were distributed at these stalls. Copies of Holy Qur'ān were also placed on these stalls and was given to those who showed special interest. The main point of these stalls was that at each stall there was a Murabbi or Nasir with religious knowledge, who answered the questions of the people and preached to 344 non-Muslim/non-Ahmadis, as a result of which many new contacts were found.

## SOCIAL MEDIA:

All regions shared the day's Tabligh activities on their region's Twitter account. The tweet of Qiādat Tabligh was conveyed to all Ansār brothers who shared and liked it from their account. 12 Regions made 26 short films of the occasion and sent them to the Qiādat Tabligh and later after obtaining permission these were shared via their Twitter accounts.

# TABLIGH BY COMPANIONS OF THE PROMISED MESSIAH (as)

Hadhrat Imam Din sahib (may Allah be pleased with him): He relates that he received a letter from someone asking him to come over with a Maulwi from Qadian because a debate was going to be held in a village. They duly arrived. During the debate the other party became insistent that they would only proceed if 'Mirza sahib's' name could be shown in the Holy Qur'an written as 'Mirza Ghulam Ahmad, son of Mirza Ghulam Murtaza'. The debate started and the Ahmadi Maulwi sahib remarked if the others could show citation of any earlier Prophets in the Qur'an complete with their parentage, they would reciprocate, but if this method was not documented as regards the earlier Prophets, why was this question raised? No sensible response was given to this argument. The person chairing the debate was a Sikh and he said the other Maulwi had no knowledge and was disparaging towards him. Thus God gave us victory. When this incident was related to the Promised Messiah (on whom be peace) he said, 'why did Maulwi sahib not say that Allah the Exalted has given my name as **'...His name will be Ahmad...'** [\(61:7\)](#) in the Qur'an?'

Hadhrat Pir Iftikhar Ahmad sahib (may Allah be pleased with him): He relates that his father believed in Hadhrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (peace be on him) during the time of his claim as a Mujaddid and propagated his message among his friends and others. He had a large poster printed for this purpose. He also contributed in financial giving along with his followers. He spent the final time of his life in propagating the message and trying to excel in financial giving.

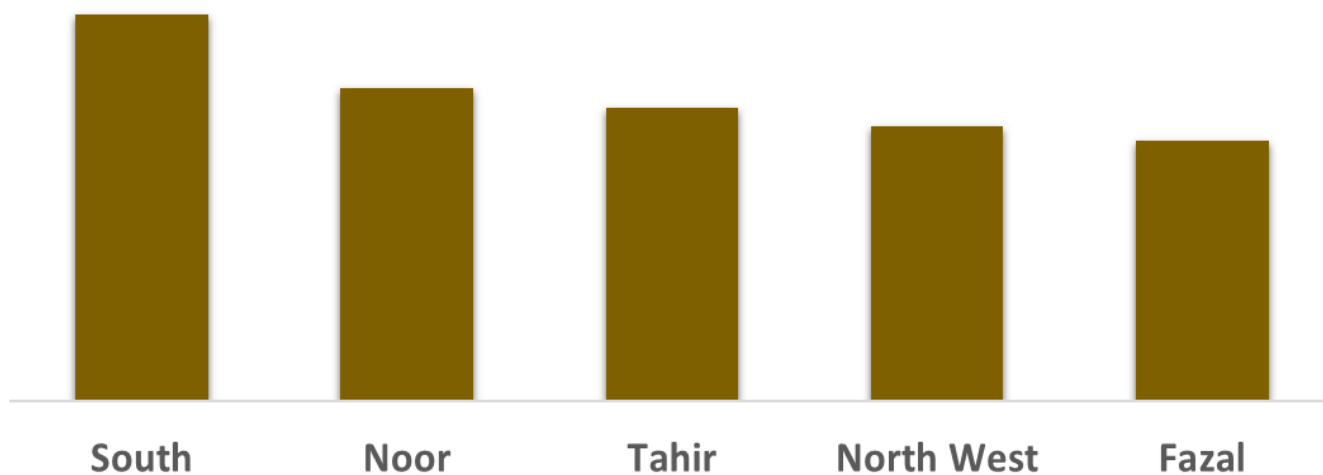

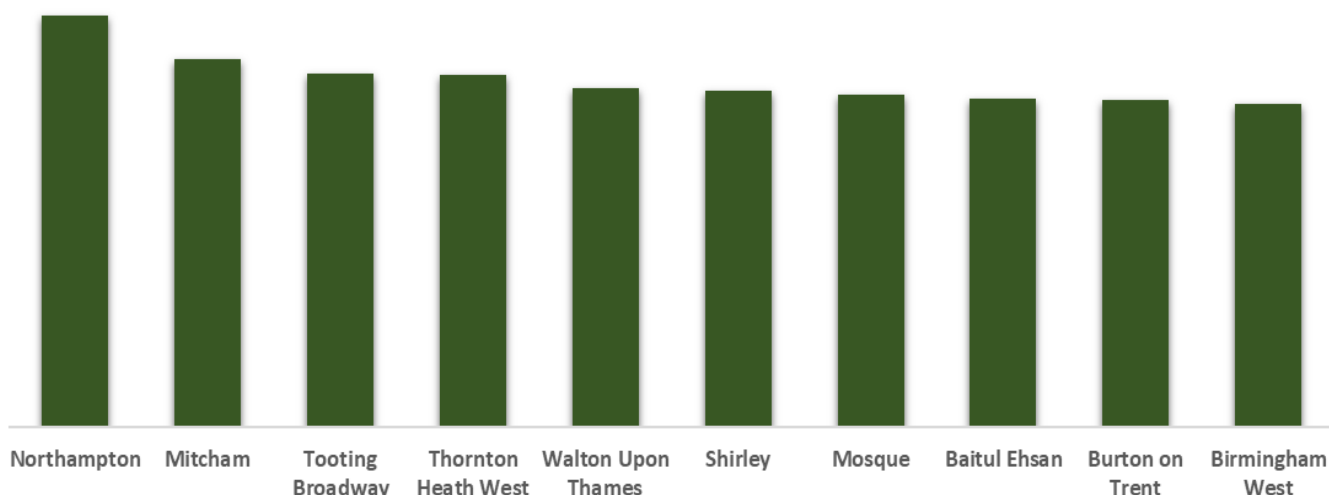

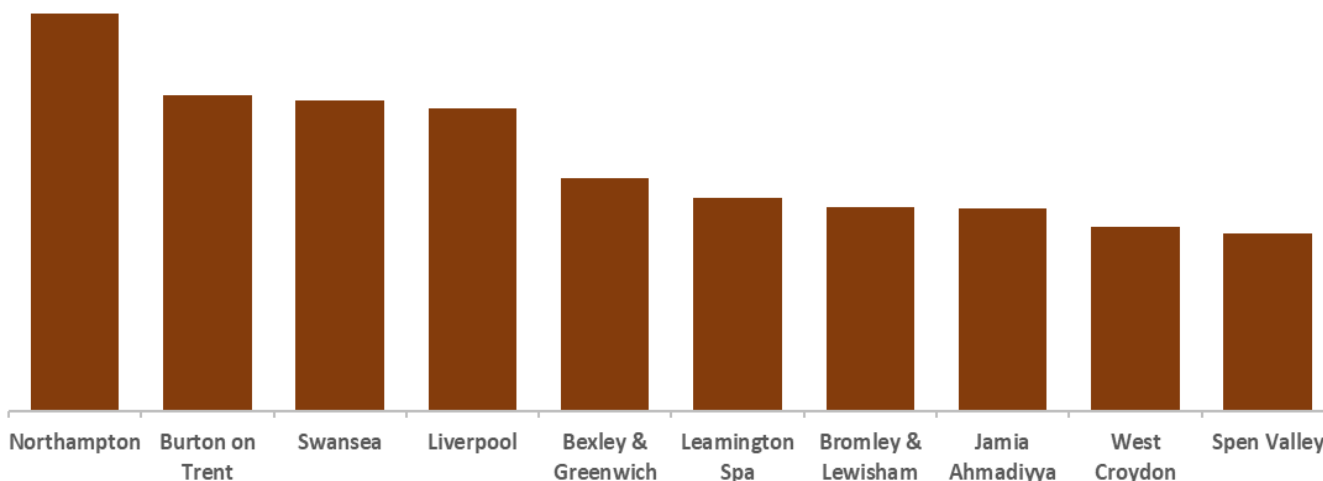

# ASHRAH TABLĪGH

(22nd – 31st October 2021)

Qiādat Tablīgh will inshaAllah be celebrating Ashrah Tablīgh from Friday 22nd October to Sunday 31st October 2021. Ashrah Tablīgh refers to a ten-days campaign where emphasis is given to the Tablīgh related activities.

For this Ashrah, key activities will be as follows:

**1) TAHAJJUD & LETTER TO HUZOOR(AA)** – Members are requested to offer regular Tahajjud prayer and to write a letter to Hazrat Khalitfatul Masih (ايداه الله تعالى بنصره العزيز) during the Ashrah requesting his prayers for achieving bai'at & success in all Tablīgh activities

**TARGET:** At least one letter to Huzoor(aa) and tahajjud prayer by National, Regional & Local Office Bearers during the Ashrah

**2) VILLAGE TABLĪGH PROJECT** – Majālis to establish contacts with charity, council, school, church, or other village-based organisations in their assigned village. Also, organise Tablīgh Stalls in allocated villages and distribute “Messiah Has Come” leaflets during the Ashrah

**TARGET:** Every Majlis to establish contact with at least one village-based organisation & share the contact details with Qiādat Tablīgh and hold minimum of 5 Tablīgh Stalls in allocated village

**3) JALSA SEERATUN NABI ﷺ** – Regions to organise Jalsa Seeratun Nabi ﷺ on any day between Fri 15th to Sun 31st October 2021. Tablīgh Contacts especially Non-Ahmadi Muslim friends should be invited; schools can also be approached to join. Focus should be given to invite maximum number of Non-Ahmadi guests but Ansār can also attend. Tablīgh Exhibitions and Q&A Session can also take place

**TARGET:** Every Region to hold at least one Jalsa Seeratun Nabi ﷺ during Ashrah

**4) TWITTER CAMPAIGN** – Qiādat Tablīgh will inshaAllah run a twitter campaign using #ProphetMuhammad on Friday 22nd October 2021 starting at 6:30 pm

**TARGET:** 50% of Tajnid to take part in #ProphetMuhammad Twitter Campaign

**5) SOCIAL MEDIA CAMPAIGN** – Qiādat Tablīgh will send daily media content to run an online

campaign on Prophet Muhammad ﷺ. Material will be provided by Qiādat Tablīgh. Regions should post the provided material using their Regional Twitter account and encourage maximum number of Ansār to re-tweet, like, comment and share with their contacts.
