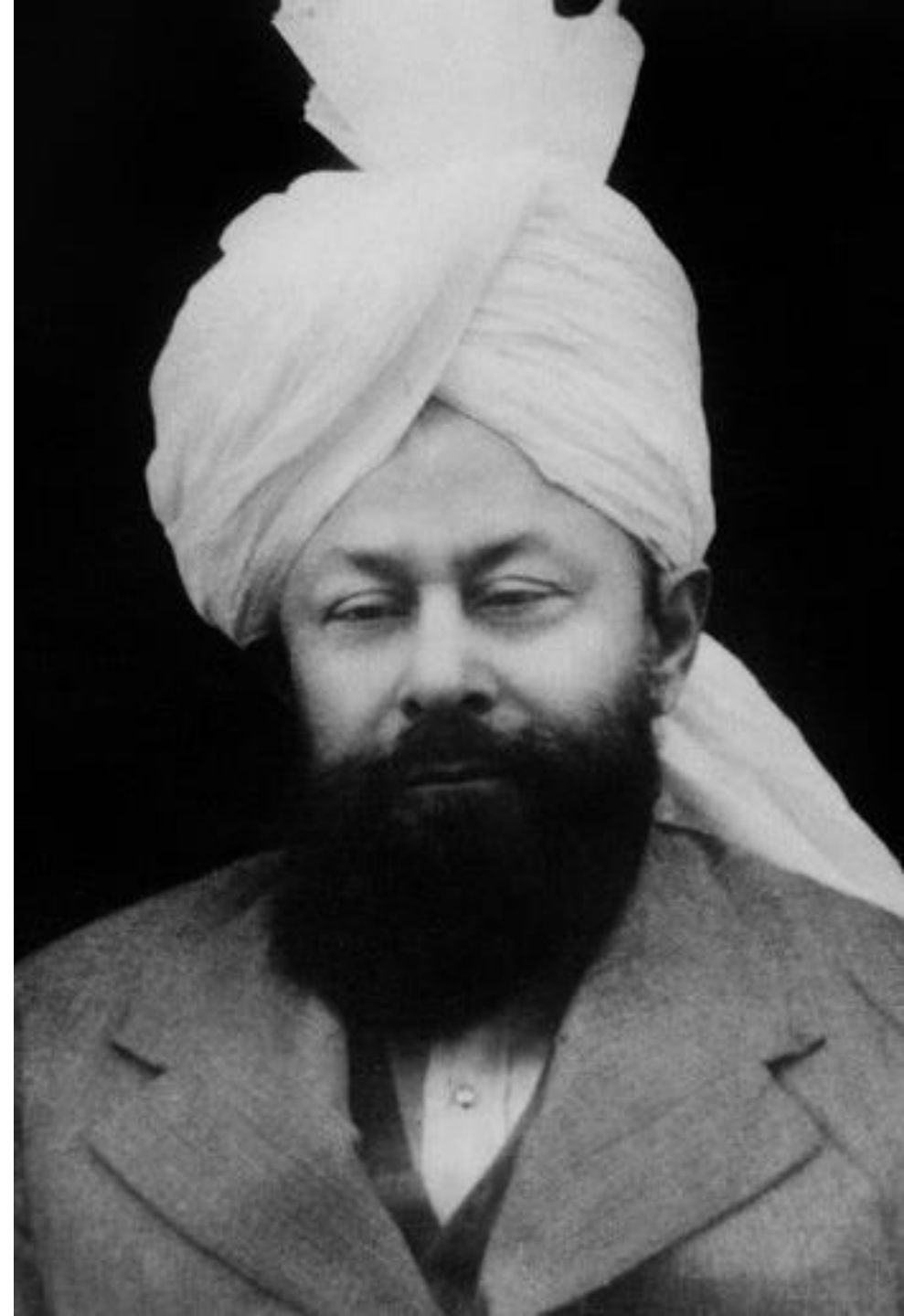
Waqf-e-Jadid

: **When**

Over 64 years ago, on December 27th, 1957

Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih II (رضي الله تعالى عنه) started the blessed project called

Tehrike **Waqf-e-Jadid**
(The New Dedication).

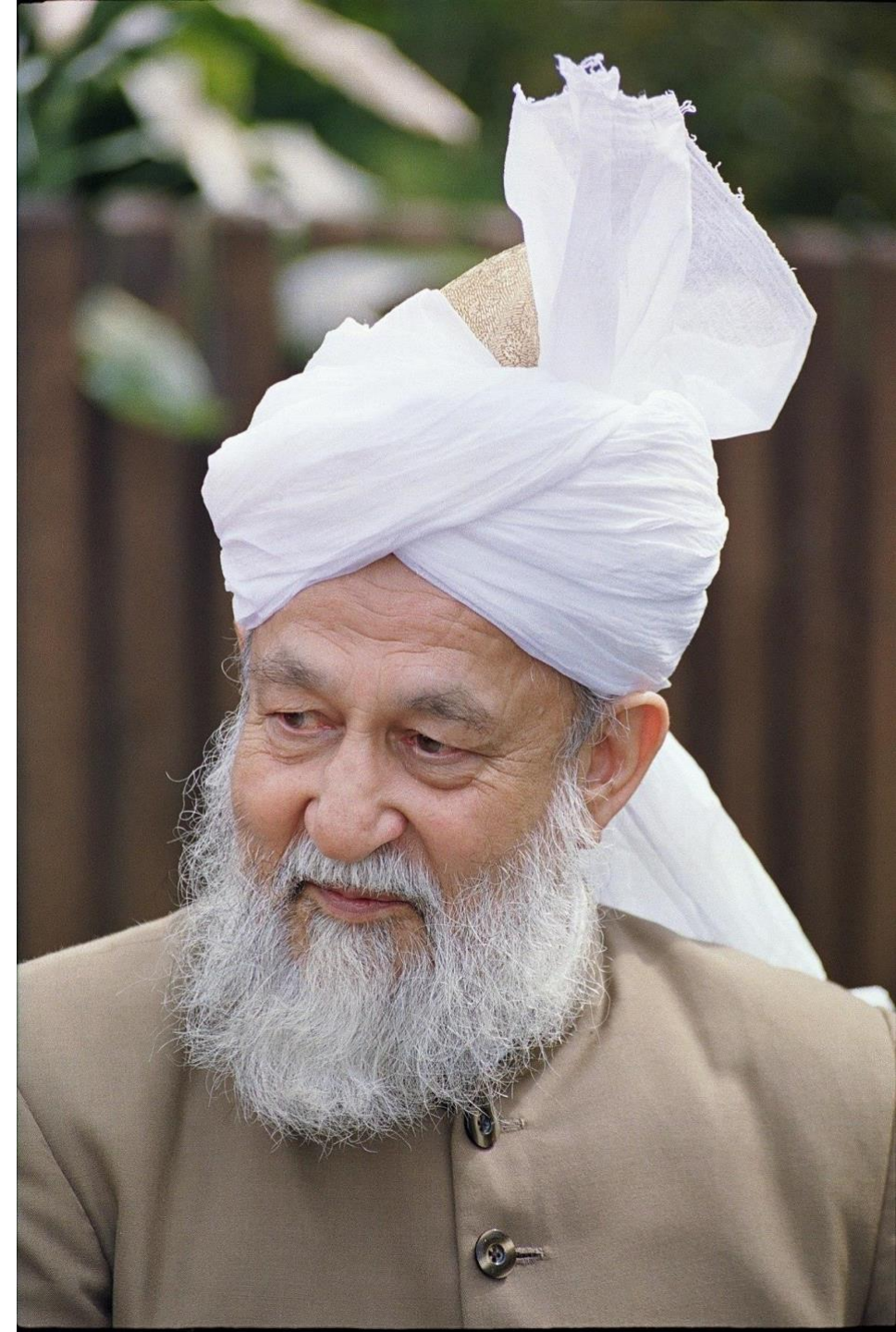


Waqf-e-Jadid

:1st Director

Sahibzada Mirza Tahir Ahmad Sahib was appointed as the first Director (**Nazim Irshad**) of Waqf-e-Jadid.

This scheme was made world-wide in 1985 by Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih IV (ra)



Waqf-e-Jadid

: Objectives

- The primary objective: to look after the spiritual upbringing of the members living in the rural communities.
- The secondary objective was to bring the message of Islam to Hindu population of the country. Up to 1986 the project was intended mainly for the rural communities of Pakistan. However, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV (ra) broadened the scope of this project and now all the countries of the world are within the scope of this plan.



Waqf-e-Jadid

: How

- Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih II (الله تعالى عنه رضي) planned to create a Network of **Mualimeen (teachers)** who should be wholly devoted to the upbringing of the members throughout the length and breadth of Pakistan.
- On 1st February 1958, fourteen Mualimeen were dispatched to selected rural areas of the country – by the grace of Allah now the number of Mualimeen are in thousands



Waqf-e-Jadid

: Importance

"This is the undertaking of Allah, and He Himself will complete it. Since it is Allah Almighty Who has put this inspiration in my heart, I shall endeavour to fulfil it even if I have to sell my house and my clothes to do so and even if not a single person assists me. Allah shall cut them off from the Jama'at who are not helping me in this regard and will send down angels from heaven to help me."

(Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih II (ra), Al Fazl, January 5th 1962)



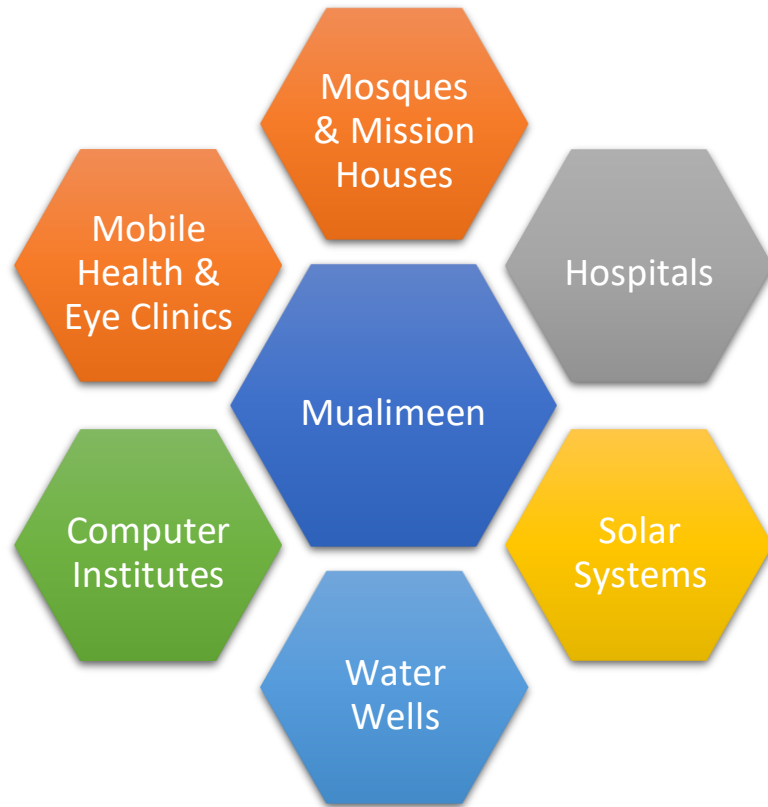
Waqf-e-Jadid

Every Majlis should ensure that all Ansar take part in this blessed scheme.

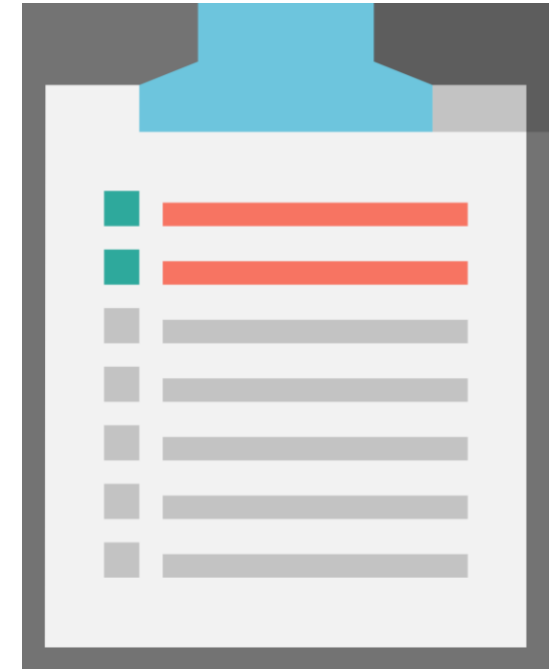


Waqf-e-Jadid : **Where**



Waqf-e-Jadid : Muntazim Majlis

1. Za'im Majlis or Muntazim Waqf-e-Jadid should request the local Sadr/Finance Secretary for a list of non-participant Ansar from the previous year and try to motivate them to take part this year.



2. Za'im Majlis or Muntazim Waqf-e-Jadid should encourage all Ansār to take part in this blessed scheme.
3. Za'im Majlis or Muntazim Waqf-e-Jadid should make every New Ahmadi Nasir to be made aware of this scheme.
4. Za'im Majlis or Muntazim Waqf-e-Jadid should ensure every Nasir as a family head, to ensure ALL members of his household participate in this divine scheme. Chanda should even be paid on behalf of new-borns.

5. Za'im Majlis or Muntazim Waqf-e-Jadid should encourage every Nasir to increase on the amount sacrificed by them in the last year.
6. Za'im Majlis or Muntazim Waqf-e-Jadid should encourage every Nasir should try to continue the sacrifices of deceased relatives who used to pay Chanda Waqf-e-Jadid.
7. Za'im Majlis or Muntazim Waqf-e-Jadid to submit how many non-participants Ansār (from the previous year) have

promised to pay this year should be given every month to the Markaz through the Regional Nazim Waqfe Jadid

Waqf-e-Jadid : Muntazim Majlis Monthly Report



Number of non-participants from previous year who have promised to pay this year should be sent to the centre.

Nazim Aa'la (region) and Nazim Waqfee-Jadid to ensure that every Majlis has a Muntazim Waqf-e-Jadid and a monthly report is sent to centre regarding contact with Every Muntazim from all their Maja'lis.
